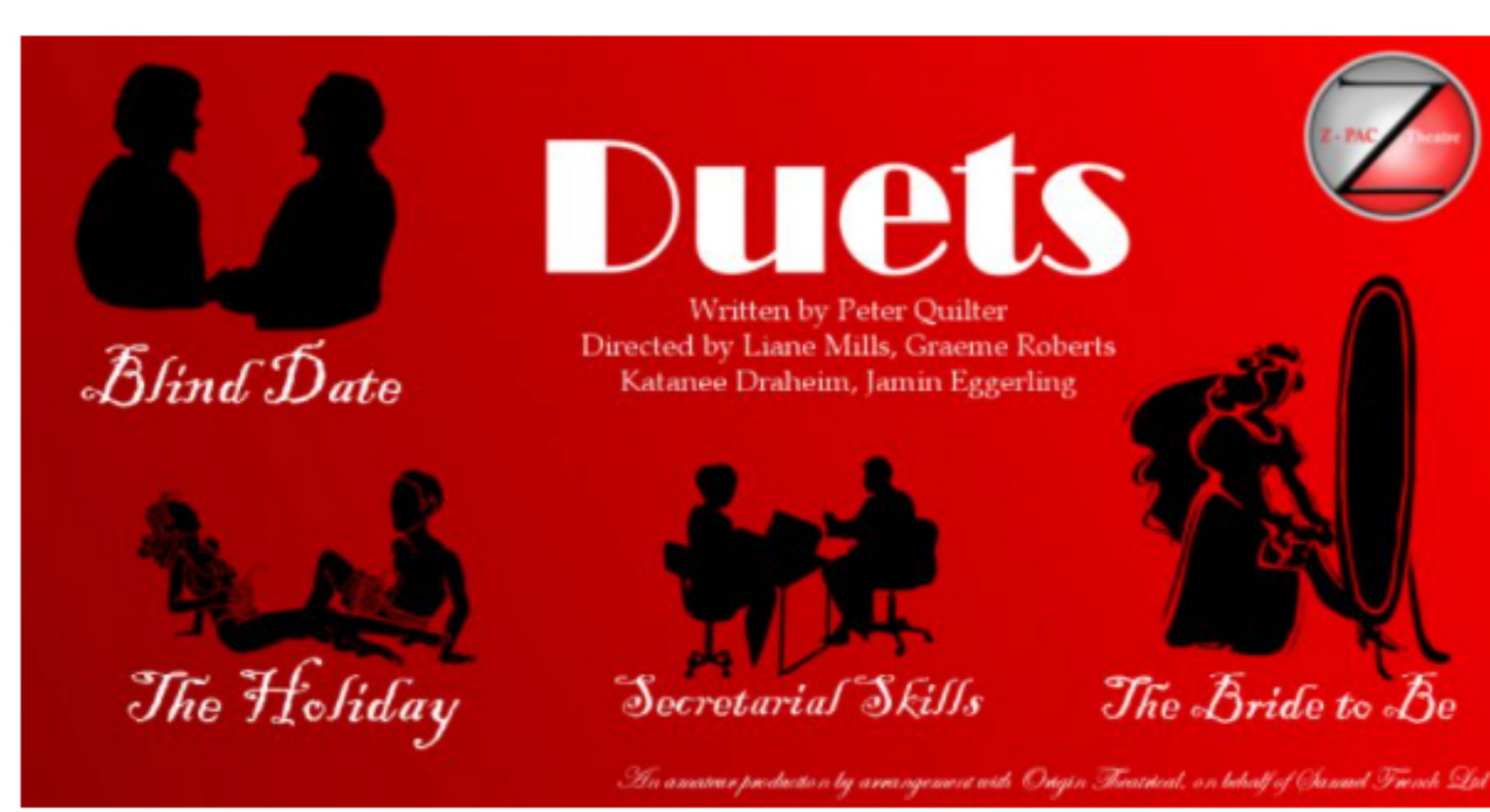


Cr George Seymour

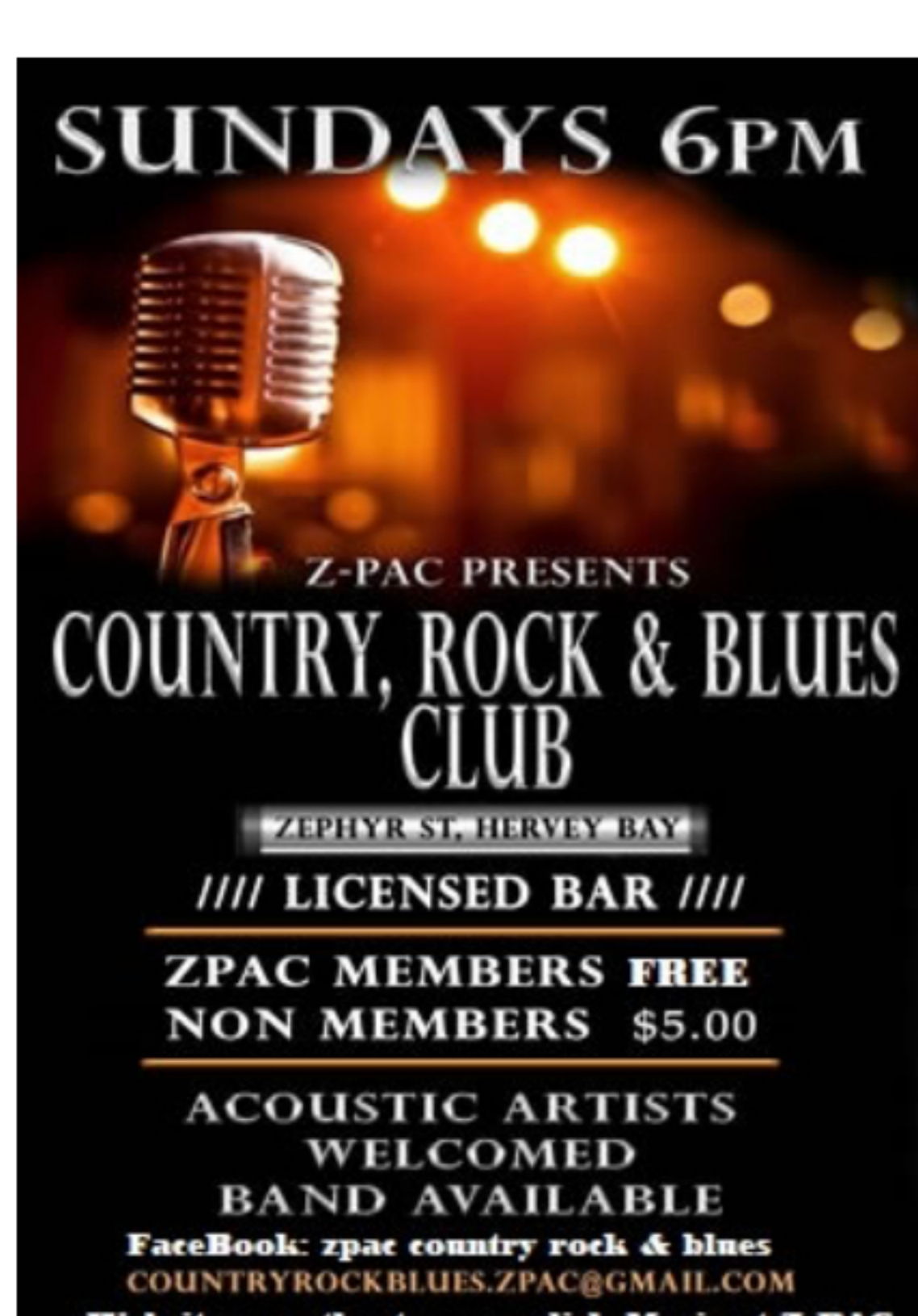
